Year 3: Who lives in Antarctica?

Geography is the study of the Earth's surface and the humans spread across it.



climate zone	Areas of the world grouped together that have similar climates.
hemisphere	One half of the Earth.
iceberg	Large chunks of floating ice that break off glaciers.
ice sheet	A layer of ice covering the land for a long period of time, also known as a glacier.
ice shelf	A thin layer of ice extending from a glacier into the sea.
lines of latitude	Invisible horizontal lines mapped on the globe that show how far north or south from the Equator a place is.
lines of longitude	Invisible horizontal lines mapped on the globe that show how far east or west from the Prime Meridian a place is.
treaty	A formal, written agreement between two places.
