## Brookfield Primary School Late Collection Policy

We are fully aware that there can be valid reasons or emergencies where parents/carers have been delayed and, when the school is informed in advance of this, we will always take an understanding view.

However, we are not able to offer a free, out of school hours, childcare service.

We operate the following School Procedures when a child is not collected on time;

- Children who are not collected by 3.10pm will be taken to the entrance area, where they will be supervised by support staff.
- If a child is not collected by 3.20pm, then they will be taken to our after-school childcare provision.
- If it is the first or second occasion of late collection during a school term, and the parent/carer has notified the school that they are held up, then no charge will be made for the supervision of the child **if the parent/carer is delayed for a short period of time.**
- There will be a charge of £2.50 per child applied to contribute to the cost to the school for supervision of children if one of the following applies:
  - 1. Any instance of late collection, with no notification, made by the parent/carer before school finishes at 3.05pm
  - 2. A third (or more) occurrence of late collection by the parent/carer in a school term
  - 3. If a child is collected more than 15 minutes late

- The charge per child will be expected to be paid on arrival. For example, if two children are collected after 3.30pm, the parent/carer would be charged a total of £5 for their supervision
- The same procedures will be in place if a child is not collected on time following an after-school enrichment club
- All late collections will be officially logged on your child's records.

In line with the school's safeguarding policy, if a child remains uncollected by 3.45pm, safeguarding processes will be started and a referral made to social care and to the police. Further attempts to contact parents to advise them of this will be made by school staff.
