Maths Find some buttons, counters, or similar objects. How many can you share them into groups? Can you explain why you have grouped them that way?	English We are reading the book 'The Three Little Pigs'. Can you retell this story to someone at home?	Reading Read your favourite book with an adult. Can you say what you like about the book?	PSHE We are all special in different ways. Talk to an adult about what makes you special. What makes someone in your family special?
Art Can you create a piece of artwork that tells us all about you. For example, can you draw your favourite hobbies or food?	RE Name an important day in your household. Can you describe and explain how and why you celebrate this day?	Computing Discuss with an adult how to stay safe online. Make a poster with your top tips for online safety.	Science Find some objects from around your house. Can you use your senses to find out about what they look, feel, smell, taste and sound like?
Music Listen to some nursery rhymes such as: • Pat-a-cake • 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, Once I Caught a Fish Alive • This Old Man • Five Little Ducks • I'm A Little Teapot • Hickory Dickory Dock	PE Go on an autumnal walk and collect some natural objects. Discuss what you notice about the objects. Discuss what they look like and feel. Can you find different ways to sort them?	History Find some pictures of you in the past. Can you put them in order from the past to now?	History Make your own Family Tree. Who is in your family? What are their names? What relation are they to you?
