Maths Pick a number from: 0 2 5 10 Count forwards and backwards from this number. Pick a number up to 20. Draw tens and ones to match this number.	English Take a picture of yourself reading in an interesting place. Could it be in the garden or reading with your pets?	Geography Draw a map of your house and garden.	Geography Take some photos of the human and physical features in your local area.
Science Draw a diagram of the body. Mark in as many different parts as you know. Make sure you spell all the names correctly: head, arm, leg, toes, elbow, ear, mouth, feet, hips, thigh, hair. How many more can you think of?	Science Find out how many ways your body can move. Try jumping as far as you can, running as far as you can in one minute and holding your balance. Notice how your bones help you move safely.	History Make a time line of things you have done since you were born. Add interesting things that you have done — like holidays or learning to ride a bike or swim. Ask an adult to help you.	History Create some drawings of things you had when you were different ages: a baby's bottle, a toy, a high chair, clothes, your first bike.
Science Try using your sense of smell. Collect some things that smell in your house and then ask an adult to blindfold you. Can you identify the smells? Try these things: Onion, lemon, coffee, tea, soap, washing powder, yoghurt, vinegar.	Maths Draw a number line, marking each of the numbers on the line. Use a ruler to help you make it as neat as you can.	PE Make up your own dance or gymnastics routine to your favourite music.	RE Draw a picture of a special occasion that your house celebrates. Can you label the key features?
