Year 3

<u>Maths</u> Starting from 0, count forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s, 10s, 20s 50s and 100s.	<u>English</u> Write a description of your house. Try to use lots of adjectives to make the description more vivid for the reader.	<u>Science</u> A hypothesis is what a scientist calls it when they think of a possible solution to a problem. Come up with your own hypothesis and write down ideas about how to test if it is true.	<u>French</u> Ask your family what French words and phrases they know. Can you practise speaking French at home? For example, can you introduce yourself, can you count to 10, do you know any colours?
<u>PSHE</u> Create a poster on how to keep healthy - your mind as well as your body.	<u>R.E</u> Ask your friends and family about their religious beliefs. What do they believe in? Are your beliefs similar? Are they different? If so how?	<u>Art</u> Cavemen drew what they saw, usually animals. Try to spot an animal in the garden (or choose one of your pets) and draw them.	<u>PE</u> Using the gymnastic skills, you have learnt, create a sequence of movements to your favourite song.
<u>Computing</u> Think about all of the digital devices you have at home. How can they be used for communication? Write a list of as many different examples as you can.	<u>Music</u> Learn the song 'Let Your Spirit Fly' by Joanna Mangona. Think about the following questions with your family. Have they heard it before? Do you like it?	<u>Geography</u> Choose a city in the UK and make a fact file. Think about things like: what is the population? What landmarks are there?	<u>History</u> Pretend you were born in the Stone Age. Draw a picture to show what your home looks like, what type of clothes you would wear and what type of food you would eat.

Please choose an activity each week with your child to complete at home. These can be completed in any order. The menu of activities supports what your child will be learning this term. Once they have completed their activity please send a photograph / video of this to their class teacher via Class Dojo. Children will go on the wheel of names for each completed activity.
