PSHE Create a poster showing that, 'It's good to be me.'
DT Visit the local playground and sketch / photograph the different structures. Focus on how the parts are joined.	RE Write a diary extract as a day in the life of a Humanist.	PE Design a game that we can play for a warm-up at the beginning of a lesson.	French Draw a picture of your family and introduce them to the class in French.
Music Review your favourite song focussing on lyrics, instrumentation and lyrics.	Computing Design a poster to support internet safety.	History Visit the local library to research facts about the history of the local area.	Geography Research factors that have affected the population of the local area.
